Can you find out for me Gov. Haley's position on the President's proposal regarding Medicaid expansion?

President Obama earlier today announced his plan to encourage the remaining 19 states that have not accepted Medicaid expansion to join with the rest of the nation. His proposal encourages states to offer health insurance to the millions of their citizens who make too much to qualify for traditional Medicaid, but too little to qualify for subsidies on the health care exchanges. The President's proposal gives those states the same three-year period of 100-percent federal support that the states that adopted Medicaid expansion in 2014 were entitled to.
