During last month's meeting, many of you expressed a desire to hear about topical issues the state is facing -- we've heard you and we are excited to announce that we will have Representative Rick Quinn as our speaker for the **February 3rd** meeting!

Very recently, Rep. Quinn announced he's filed new legislation to reform laws on business license fees and cap the amounts that cities and towns can charge. Quinn called the present system "grossly unfair and an outrageous assault on small business." The new legislation that Rep. Quinn is proposing can potentially have a huge effect on the landscape of attracting small business to SC.

Quinn is a Lexington native and attended the University of South Carolina (where he was elected president of the College Republicans).
