At our first Financing and Affordability Committee meeting, members noted that having a better understanding of the flow of dollars into (and within) our system of long-term services and supports would be critical to our work moving forward. In a follow-up to that discussion, the committee co-chairs have asked that I contact key agency representatives to share funding information with the group at our April 10<sup>th</sup> meeting. As such, I am reaching out to you to see if you and/or your staff could provide information about the funding that flows to and through the Lt. Governor's Office on Aging.
