Dear Governor Haley,

I am a former resident of South Carolina. My husband is from Charleston and we lived in Greenville from 2013 through 2014. We moved to Seattle in 2014. Part of the reason that we stayed in Greenville for such a short time had to do with the racist behavior I saw exhibited by young, well-educated, privileged residents of South Carolina. I was appalled to hear the n word used casually in polite conversation. I was shocked to see the enthusiasm displayed by South Carolinians for the Confederate flag. While I understand that the flag symbolizes pride for history and enthusiasm for state's rights, it also symbolizes a terrible time for minorities in the South. A state like South Carolina, that outwardly professes to be a community for all races, does not appear to consider how it feels to be a minority and see a flag waving in front of government buildings that, to them, symbolizes hatred and oppression.

This type of behavior financially hurts South Carolina. My husband and I are a perfect example of this. My husband and I are attorneys. We worked hard when we lived in Greenville and spent lots of our income supporting the local economy of South Carolina. We enjoyed the outdoor activities, the low cost of living, and the friendly people. But we could not stand the lack of diversity, racial segregation of the communities, and the hyper-conservative atmosphere. When sitting for the bar exam, I was shocked to see how few examinees were African Americans. For a state that is 27% black, I would estimate the number of black examinees was under 10%. My husband was offered a job in Seattle, and we jumped at the opportunity to return to the Great Northwest. My husband loved the firm he worked at in South Carolina and the firm struggled to replace him. Firms in South Carolina admittedly struggle to attract talented individuals because of the reputation the South

has for lack of diversity and extreme conservatism. My husband ended up returning to work at his firm in Greenville, but does so remotely. This means that the very high income the firm pays directly benefits the economy of Seattle, Washington, rather than Greenville, South Carolina.

I cannot tell you how thankful I am to see South Carolina finally acknowledge that the state should not be displaying such a terrible symbol. I am saddened that it has taken nine black lives to make this happen. My husband and I can see a glimmer of hope that some day South Carolina will live up to its espoused ideals and then we may be able to hold our heads up that we have a connection to such a state. Thank you for taking a huge step in the right direction.

The funeral processions to the graveyards in Charleston will be crowded unless the families can keep out the interlopers, exploiters and other cheap opportunists. The easy riders have hitched up their hobbyhorses for the big parade.

Some of the long riders want to shoot down the Confederate flag. Others have oiled their long rifles for the promised cavalry charge against the National Rifle Association. Even the Arabs, who have never distinguished themselves on a battlefield, want to join the mob to avenge murder of Christians at Charleston.

The soldiers of CAIR, the loudest Muslim lobbying organization, joins the crusade to tear down the

Confederate flag wherever they find it, as "a fitting memorial to those slain in one of America's deadliest acts of racist violence." CAIR needs help with American history. Massacre at the World Trade Center, where more than 3,000 Americans were slain for the sin of being Christians, Jews and unbelievers, set the standard for massacre. Punks and crazies eager to get their names in the Guinness Book of Records will be shooting at 9/11 for decades to come.

Gov. Nikki Haley, the governor of South Carolina, surrendered to the mob late Monday, joining the demand to send the Confederate flag to "the dustbin of history," as one leader of the mob put it. The governor called the rally, where several state officials, including Sen. Lindsey Graham, gathered in a ceremony to join the mob, "a moment of unity." The Republican National Committee, always eager to cower in the face of controversy, praised the governor. Chairman Reince Priebus assured everyone that he has been praying for South Carolina but forgot the "thoughts" that politicians, not known for dropping to their knees except before donors, usually attach to their "prayers" when they invoke cliches on occasions of tragedy.

There's an argument for furling the banner of Lee, Jackson and the Confederate soldiers who died in great numbers defending kith, kin, home and hearth from plundering invading armies, and thoughtful men and women could make that argument. None have tried. Taking down the flag from government buildings won't eliminate the flag from abuse of the trash who despoil it, nor would it relieve the pain of those rendered prostrate by the sight of the St. Andrews Cross fluttering in the breeze. The flag will almost certainly become more popular than ever as an act of defiance of the politically correct who dream of strangling free speech and all expressions of opinion not Officially Approved. If the flag is so bad, where have they been all these years?

A certain kind of Republican, like the worthies at the national committee, is always eager to prove that "we're not as bad as you think," and expect to be rewarded with flattering mentions in the press. It never happens, and they never learn. They dream of surrendering on "immigration reform," too, and would cave on the Second Amendment as well but for their fears, soundly based, that if they do they will never be heard from again.

Hillary Clinton's Charleston shtick is not the Confederate flag, but guns, and how to best exploit the Charleston tragedy. "Let's just cut to the chase," she told one interviewer. "It's guns and we have to have a better balance." No guns on one hand, and no guns on the other hand is the perfect balance she prescribes. She and Bubba have been successful robbers without guns, so who needs them?

Taking a cue from their partisan leader, the Democrats are trying to out-do each other in coming up with the most deeply purple eloquence against shooting people in church. (They're all against it.) Sen. Bernie Sanders, the strongest, or at least the most visible, needle in Hillary's backside, talks not of the Confederate flag or guns but "the ugly stain of racism."

Martin O'Malley, the former governor of Maryland, uses a urinary vulgarism to express the depth of his disdain for shooting children. "I'm [urinating]," he says. "I'm [urinating] that we're actually asking ourselves the horrific question of 'what will it take?'"

Not quite every politician is acting the jerk. Gov. Chris Christie of New Jersey understands that further refining of gun laws won't prevent another massacre. The urge to kill and maim lies not in laws. Only a change in the culture, as slow and painful as that may be, he told a gathering of the Faith and Freedom Coalition, will do that.

If every Confederate flag had long ago been hauled down and burned, if racism had been banished completely, Dylann Roof, a young man with a distorted soul, hatred in his heart and armed with determination, would still have satisfied his sick urge to kill. Evil will find a way to the willing heart. Robert E. Lee's flag has nothing to do with it.

The Confederate Flag is not a symbol of hate, but it been made into one by ignorant people. It is up to you and I to change that. Keep the flag where it flies.

Dear Govenor Haley,

I am a 54 yo CHRISTIAN female who came to SC to retire last year. I am from NJ and purchased a home last August (with my retirement money) so that I would be Mortgage Free. I consider myself Blessed to have this opportunity. Not only did I purchase my home outright, but I spent another \$50k to remodel it completely. I support local businesses, my community, and am active in my local church.

I visited Columbia twice before house hunting. During one of my early visits I visited the Capitol grounds - particularly that awful flag. I had NO IDEA it even existed anymore - let alone be on display on Government Property. I took pictures to share with friends and family up north. Everyone I shared it with was shocked, disgusted, and in disbelief. As I walked by, circled around, and prayed against it last summer I had this sick feeling in my Spirit. I was grieved that the sins of our fathers persisted and continued to CURSE this beautiful city.

I have been riveted by the events of the past few weeks and cheered in my living room as I watched your directive to TAKE THE FLAG DOWN. I was so proud that you are my Govenor "for a time such as this."

Last evening I found out about the Klan rally scheduled for July 18 from a friend (African-American Northerner who moved here 5 years ago).

My friend is a 62 yo Vietnam War Veteran who served as a Medic. He spent his entire career in the

healthcare field - particularly in psychiatry - ever since. He described visiting downtown Columbia during a previous rally (unbeknownst to him). As he got closer to the barricade he was stopped by a police officer who told him not to go any further as the Klan was there.

I cannot imagine what it was like to have survived Vietnam and yet could not walk down a street in Columbia, SC in present day.

I am urging you to intervene in any way possible to SHUT THIS RALLY DOWN. The Klan represents a symbol of HATE at its worst - and I would submit to you it is the Original American Born TERRORIST CELL. I put it in the same category as the swastika.
