Some of the smaller banks may have not been unable to open at all. I also understand that you declared a state of emergency for the South Carolina on October 1, 2015.

As such I respectfully request, pursuant to S.C. Code § 53-5-55, that you issue an order declaring all days during the existence of the state of emergency to be declared legal holidays.
