1. Enrollment projections and optimum future enrollments of undergraduate students in the public colleges and universities
2. Articulation
 - a. High school to college (identification of characteristics of student pool and of ways to facilitate transition from school to college, Advanced Placement, etc.)
 - b. Transfer of credits from two-year to senior colleges
 - c. Interinstitutional cooperation and articulation
3. Academic Affairs
 - a. Prerequisites for freshman admission to public senior colleges and universities (1988)
 - b. Teacher Improvement
 - (1) Matching funds for grant to USC, Clemson, and the Charleston Consortium from National Science Foundation (NSF) for professional development of science and mathematics teachers in Grades 7-12.
