The Budget Commission met in the Governor's office at 3:00 o'clock on October 24, 1945. All members of the Commission were present.

The following allotments were approved from the Civil Contingent Fund:

The Legislative Committee on Insurance Laws - \$3,000.00

The Governor's Office

Salary & Expense of Coast Guard Officer - 5 months - \$2,000.00

The South Carolina Probation & Parole Board - Part year salary for additional Probation Officer - \$1,200.00

The Carolina Bonded Storage Company - Rent on storage space for Civilian Defense Property for the month of October - \$25.00.

The R. L. Bryan Company - Supplies - \$41.00.

Word was received from the State Ports Authority that no request for funds for operation of the port would be made at this time.

It was agreed that the Commission would meet on November 5, 6, 7, and 8, to conduct hearings on appropriation requests for the fiscal year 1946-47.

The Commission then adjourned.
