

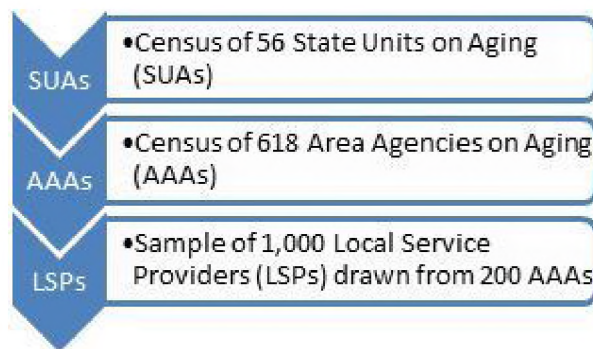

The Administration for Community Living (ACL) is conducting an evaluation of the Older Americans Act Title III-E National Family Caregiver Support Program (NFCSP). The purpose of the study is to examine how the NFCSP provides much-needed support services to family caregivers of older adults and people with disabilities. ACL has contracted with The Lewin Group (Lewin) to conduct this study.
