Eason Memorial Baptist Church in Eastover, South Carolina is a historical landmark building. On October 4, 2015 the date of the 1000 year flood, the building suffered devastating damages. We are currently unable to have worship services in the sanctuary. Our building was not flooded by the ground but due to the design of our roof. The water overflowed the paraffin wall that surrounds our roof. Our scupper system was unable to handle the volume of water causing the water to overflow the drainage penetrating the walls entering our building ruining the floor, cracking the walls, and damaging the electrical system. Over \$400,000 in repair are needed from contractors to restore the church. This is an unexpected cost that our small congregation is unable to handle. Like most churches in the area, we have been denied by our insurance company. We undergo annual inspections that we always pass but in this situation the insurance is denying us our claim.

Our mission is to help rebuild here at Eason Memorial so that we may carry out God's commandment to help all who are in need and give them a place to come and worship with the Lord. This is the cause for which we are seeking donations from generous people like you, so that our mission can be accomplished, and we can succeed in spreading the message of our Lord and Savior.
