Good morning. The South Carolina Department of Education (SCDE) has filed a motion for a stay regarding the U.S. Department of Education's (USDE) decision to cut \$36,202,909 in IDEA funds allocated for South Carolina. The motion was filed with the Fourth Circuit Court of Appeals. As required by the rules of the Fourth Circuit, SCDE asked USDE to consent to the motion for a stay; USDE declined to give consent. I've attached the motion for a stay and accompanying attachments.

SCDE also filed a petition for review. The SCDE will file briefs and additional paperwork at the appropriate time. I've attached the petition for review. The federal delegation has been informed of this information.
