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Watermelon Field Day Announced At the Edisto Research and Education Center

The Clemson Extension Service, the South Carolina Department of Agriculture, and the South Carolina Watermelon Association are pleased to announce that the Second Annual Watermelon field day will be held at the Edisto Research and Education Center in Blackville, South Carolina, on Thursday, July 11, beginning at 4:00 pm. All watermelon producers and other producers interested in vegetable research projects currently being conducted at the Edisto Station are invited to attend the field day.

Growers can expect to see variety trials for seedless watermelon, a row spacing study, a nutrient study using slow release fertilizers, and a study of the effectiveness of the chemical Sandea. There is also a flower to fruit study to determine the actual field time required from pollination to fruit ready for harvest. A seedless watermelon variety trial planted on white plastic in late June will also be observed. Cantaloupes seeded on several different types of reflective mulch are being looked at and early results can be seen at the field day.

USDA Polls Cotton Industry On Cotton Program Referendum

At the request of the Agricultural Marketing Service, the Farm Service Agency is conducting a sign-up period from June 3 through August 30, 2002, to provide cotton producers an opportunity to request a referendum on whether to continue the 1991 amendments to the Cotton Research and Promotion Program.

In 1991, USDA instituted non-refundable assessments on all U.S. Upland cotton and the authority to collect assessments on imported cotton and cotton imported textiles as amendments to the Cotton Research and Promotion Order. The Order implements the 1966 Cotton Research and Promotion Act.

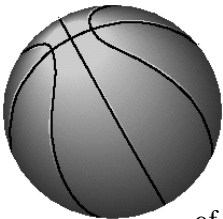

Commissioner's Column

NCAA Bans Leather on the Courts



Recently, I learned that the National College Athletic Association (NCAA) made the decision to replace regulation leather basketballs with synthetic basketballs at the urging of a radical group of animal rights activists called PETA (People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals).

As Commissioner of Agriculture of the State of South Carolina, I am appalled that the NCAA would even think of bowing to the whims of this fanatical group.

PETA is an activist group in that it strives to scare humans in the name of animal rights. The animal rights movement is not about the humane treatment of animals. It's really about the cruel treatment of humans. It's cruel to prohibit testing that could cure diseases like cancer and AIDS. PETA has openly supported radical organizations that break into university research laboratories to destroy vital biomedical research programs. It's also barbaric to encourage our youth to give up milk in favor of beer. And, it's irresponsible to take away consumers' right to choose what they eat, wear, or use to play sports.

Along with many others in the livestock industry, I have contacted the NCAA President asking for the organization to choose leather basketballs and denounce this group's ridiculous quest to ban leather goods from sports. If leather is prohibited on the courts, the players will go barefooted. If meat and milk are banned from the games, hotdogs and ice cream will be snatched from the fans. The absurd scenarios go on and on. Meanwhile, no matter how many hoops the NCAA jumps through for an activist group like this, the colleges and universities in the NCAA and their many supporters end up the losers.

Because animals are their livelihood, livestock owners are actively involved in their animals' welfare. They don't need PETA to tell them how to care for their animals. It's one thing to be concerned about the welfare of animals. It's another to be fanatical about the rights of animals.

Animals were placed on this earth in the care of man, and mankind is responsible for their welfare, but animals do not have the same rights as man. Rights are ethical principles applicable only to beings capable of reason and choice. When animal rights activists like this violate human rights, everyone loses---farmers and non-farmers alike.

In the last report from SC Agricultural Statistics Service, cash receipts for livestock and livestock products totaled \$792 million. Cattle and calves along with broilers and turkeys accounted for 51% of that total. Each of these livestock industries works hard to add value to their products. Cowhide is a value-added product that would otherwise be wasted. One cowhide produces about 12 basketballs, and hides tanned in the United States are worth about \$4 billion in finished leather. The livestock sector as a whole is by far South Carolina's largest agricultural industry. Banning animal products from basketball arenas or from any other area of life affects everyone.

I am deeply disappointed that the NCAA has allowed a radical animal rights group to call the shots for its member or ganizations. I urge you to contact the NCAA and ask them to rescind their new policy and return to the leather basketball---a high-quality product that is humanely produced.

In addition, growers will look at breeding lines of bell pepper, developed at the Charleston USDA Vegetable Research Laboratory, that show potential nematode resistance. There are also research plots that study the effectiveness of Telone for nutgrass and nematode control, plant back intervals for pepper, tomato, eggplant, and cucumber on Telone EC, and specialized compost for use in nematode control. There is something for all vegetable producers at this field day.

As required by the Act, USDA reviewed the program to determine whether a referendum on continuing these amendments was needed. USDA issued a decision that a referendum was unnecessary in the January 14, 2002, Federal Register. However, the Act requires such a decision to be followed with an opportunity for producers and importers to request a referendum.

Producers desiring a referendum should make requests to the County FSA Office where the producer owns or rents land. If the producer owns or rents land in more than one county, the producer should make requests to their Control County Office. No action is necessary if a referendum is not desired.

To move to a referendum, the numerical equivalent of 10 percent (4,622) of the number voting in the last referendum would have to request a referendum, and no more than 20 percent of all requests can be from one state or from importers.
