The single-story Ranch house stands six bays wide and rests on a brick foundation. The building is clad in brick and topped with side-gabled roof. A recessed porch is off-centered on the building's facade and holds the primary entrance and two windows, all of which are replacement. The porch is supported by two wooden columns. An interior brick chimney stack rises from the building's roof and is topped with a metal chimney cap.
