## **CMS releases tool to map Medicare disparities**

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Office of Minority Health has released a new interactive map to increase understanding of geographic disparities in chronic disease among Medicare beneficiaries. The map is an excellent starting point to understand geographic, racial, and ethnic differences in health outcomes. It is also a useful supplement to NCOA's visualization tools that map concentrations of low-income Medicare beneficiaries who are American Indians/Alaskan/Hawaiian Natives, living with disabilities, and have limited English proficiency.

## **Be advised of disability benefits fraud**

The Social Security Office of the Inspector General (OIG) is warning citizens to be aware of phone calls from unknown people who claim to have information about a citizen's application for disability benefits.

The callers appear to be "phishing" for personal information—such as Social Security numbers—from citizens who may have applied for disability benefits and thus might be inclined to provide information in furtherance of his or her claim.
