Weather conditions continue to be challenging in the northern part of the state. Oconee, Pickens, Greenville, Spartanburg, Cherokee, Chester, Lancaster, and York all report roads covered or partially covered with snow and ice. SCDOT crews will work through the night to ensure roads are safe to travel. Detailed District ops report attached.
