South Carolina became the first state in the nation to be fully certified as work ready. By becoming certified will assist all regions of the state attract new business and retain current business by showing there is a skilled labor pool ready to take on the available jobs. More than 353,000 people have take the WorkKeys test, which measures a person's skills including applied mathematics, reading and critical thinking. Roughly 3,100 businesses are involved in the [S.C.
