WHEREAS, in his college career, Marcus has rushed 555 times for 2,677 yards and has set school records with 38 rushing and 41 total touchdowns, including a 28-yard touchdown run against the Tennessee Vols; and

WHEREAS, Marcus has earned the respect of his teammates, fans, and people across the nation as an outstanding leader, exceptional athlete, and model citizen as was evidenced by the outpouring of support and concern from Gamecock Nation and beyond following his second consecutive season-ending injury.
