

Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Producers- Is Your Broker/Handler Properly Licensed?

As the spring season for fresh South Carolina fruits and vegetables begins, Martin Eubanks, Senior Marketing specialist with the South Carolina Department of Agriculture, reminds producers and growers that anyone acting as a broker or handler on their behalf must be properly licensed to operate in the Palmetto State. A Dealers and Handlers License is required for anyone who acts as a broker or handler of fruits and vegetables in South Carolina.

Producers and growers should ask questions of anyone who handles sales for them. If a handler pays by check, he must be bonded through the South Carolina Department of Agriculture. If he pays by cash, he must have a Cash Affidavit on file with the South Carolina Department of Agriculture. These requirements are in place to protect producers in the event of non-payment for their goods and growers are encouraged to ask their broker if they meet these requirements.

"It is important for growers to deal with properly licensed and bonded individuals or firms for their protection," said Louie Conder, Warehouse and Dealer Licensing Program Coordinator with the South Carolina Department of Agriculture. "Don't wait until after the fact to properly check on anyone that you are doing business with this spring and summer," he says.

Celebrating SC's Dairy Industry---June Dairy Month

For the 64th year in a row, June Dairy Month returns to teach us about the value of milk and milk products to our health and economic wellbeing.

As you sit down to a cool glass of refreshing milk in the morning, think about how far we have come in recent years. No longer only offered in glass bottles on the doorstep, milk is sold by the gallons at local grocery stores. And, we can buy all types of cheeses and a myriad of flavors of ice cream--thanks to the dairy industry in this state and nation.

Although not the largest industry in our state, the dairy industry remains an important part of our economy. In 2000, cash receipts from the marketing of milk in SC totaled \$51.6 million, according to SC Agricultural Statistics. Total milk production was 369 million pounds, unchanged from the previous year. That's about 46 million gallons of milk which sounds like a lot until you look a little closer.

With 4 million people in South Carolina today, that 46 million gallons of milk would provide only 11.5 gallons for each man, woman, and child in a year. The average person consumes about 24 gallons of milk per year either by the glass or in other foods. Add to that the amount of cottage cheese, cream cheese, and other cheeses, ice cream, butter, and other dairy products we consume, and even though our dairy families are producing more per cow than ever before, about 50-60% of our milk is imported.

While the average person is drinking less milk than those 10 years ago, we're eating much more cheese, according to the last USDA consumption report. Per capita consumption of cheese has increased 162% in the last 20 years, the largest increase in per capita consumption of any other food.

Since 1990, SC has lost 100 dairy farms. Why? The average price to dairymen per hundred pounds of milk decreased again from \$16.30 in 1999 to \$14.10 in 2000. Like other sectors of agriculture, it's getting more and more difficult to make a living with extremely low farm prices and high production costs. At the same time, the retail cost of milk remains about the same.

We can assist the 112 commercial dairies still operating in this state--the men and women who work from dawn to dusk, 365 days a year, to supply our milk needs. We can support them and, at the same time, contribute to our health by buying and drinking milk and using milk products in our diets, especially the diets of our children.

The Southeastern United Dairy Industry Association (SUDIA) and the American Dairy Association (ADA) are focusing on children and young mothers. "Connecting Kids with Cheese Nutrition" takes a look at simple steps mothers can take to introduce dairy into their children's diets. From simply making fun shapes in slices of American cheese to adding cottage cheese and fruit to wafers, mothers can encourage their children to eat healthy, nutritious dairy products. And, the SC Dairy Association also does its part to encourage healthy diets with their annual Ice Cream under the Veranda on the State House grounds. On behalf of the state's dairy industry--from the smallest one-cow farm to the largest commercial operation--I commend these organizations for their efforts to keep milk and milk products in the minds and bodies of everyone--young and young at heart.

Milk and milk products are the best sources for calcium and other nutrients. Not only does milk keep bones healthy and make the heart strong, but it also contributes to a sound body. Recent evidence has also shown that milk consumption plays a role in helping control weight. According to the Journal of the Federation of American Societies for Experimental Biology, a diet high in low-fat dairy causes fat cells to make less fat and turns on the machinery to break down fat. This translates into lower risks for obesity.

In addition, low-fat dairy products help control high blood pressure counts due to a new eating plan, Dietary Approaches to Stop Hypertension (DASH). This plan encourages a diet of three low-fat dairy products and eight to ten fruits and vegetables daily. A Harvard study preformed in 1997 showed that the DASH diet could reduce blood pressure, even as effectively as some medicines.

If you're like me, the best way to celebrate June Dairy Month and Father's Day is a big bowl of homemade peach cobbler topped with a scoop or two of vanilla ice cream and a glass of cold milk. What an enjoyable way to cool off, stay healthy, and support the dairy industry at the same time!
