- WHEREAS,** congenital heart defects are considered to be the most common birth defects and are a leading cause of birth defect related deaths worldwide; and
- WHEREAS,** more than 1 million people across America were born with some type of congenital heart defect; and
- WHEREAS,** approximately 40,000 babies in the United States are born with a congenital heart defect every year, though some are not diagnosed until months or years after birth; and
- WHEREAS,** tragically, undiagnosed congenital heart conditions cause many cases of sudden cardiac death in young athletes; and
- WHEREAS,** Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week provides an opportunity to recognize the courage of children with heart defects and their families, remember loved ones lost to congenital heart defects, and honor the medical professionals who dedicate themselves to researching and treating this condition.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim February 7 - 14, 2016, as
