## **Some Tax Payers Received Incorrect 1095-A Forms, Health Insurance Marketplace Statement**

It was just announced that approximately 20% of all individuals who enrolled in health coverage through the Health Insurance Marketplace in 2014 received incorrect 1095-A Forms, Health Insurance Marketplace Statement. The error was with Part III, Column B: Monthly Premium Amount of Second Lowest Cost Silver Plan; incorrect amounts were entered here. For those individuals affected, updated 1095-A Forms will be mailed out, and individuals should expect to receive them the beginning of March.

If your form is affected by this issue, you should get a call and/or email from HealthCare.gov in the next few days. You can also find out if you are affected by logging in to your account at [HealthCare.gov](http://HealthCare.gov). Once you log in, you should select your 2014 application, and then select "Tax forms." You will see a message that will let you know if your form was or was not affected. Your corrected form should also be here once it is completed.

### **What to do if you were affected:**

- If you already filed your taxes, do not do anything else yet! The Treasury Department will provide additional information soon. Preliminary research has shown that only five to ten percent of those that were affected by this error have already filed their taxes.
- If you have NOT already filed your taxes, you should wait to file until you receive your corrected 1095-A from the Marketplace. If you cannot wait, you will need to look up the premium for your second lowest cost silver plan (SLCSP) using this <https://www.healthcare.gov/taxes/tools/silver/>.
