Description/Significant Features:

Single story, side-gabled storage building; frame building has four open bays on its northern elevation, with its rear section of the western portion enclosed and accessible by a double entry door on the west elevation. Eastern bay is open from front to back and appears to be an extension of the original roofline; the eastern elevation has a single, tall opening with no door and the roof framing protrudes through the siding. The western and southern portions of the building have wooden board-and-batten exterior, while the eastern elevation has plain, vertical wooden siding.
