The Budget Commission met on August 12, 1944, in the Governor's Office at 4:00 P. M. All members of the Commission were present.

Mr. H. W. Scott of the Public Service Commission appeared before the Budget Commission, seeking assurance that the Budget Commission would later approve a transfer of funds to meet the cost of conducting a survey of the freight rate on coal shipped into South Carolina. The Budget Commission assured Mr. Scott that such a transfer would be granted; and that the Public Service Commission could, upon this assurance, proceed with the inauguration of this activity.

Mr. Julian Bush, Attorney for the Unemployment Compensation Commission, appeared before the Budget Commission, requesting a loan of \$10,000.00 from the Contingent Fund for National Defense to meet the initial needs of

the Unemployment Compensation Commission in granting unemployment aid to returning War Veterans under the terms of the Federal Act. The loan will be repaid as soon as funds are provided by Congress.

The Commission instructed the Secretary to communicate with Dr. Wm. P. Jacobs in connection with the expense account claimed by Mr. J. Lincoln Moore for the months of July, August, September and October, 1943; and to authorize the payment of this expense account if approved by Dr. Jacobs.

The Commission then adjourned.
