SECTION 1: Judge G. Ross Anderson administered the oath of office to Commission Chairman V. Laniel Chapman. Chairman Chapman thanked the Commission for the opportunity to serve as chairman and pledged to exercise the duties of that office to the best of his abilities.

The Reverend Larry Jenkins administered the oath of office to Commission Vice Chairman Thomas A. Drayton. Vice Chairman Drayton also thanked the Commission for the opportunity to serve and pledged his support of Chairman Chapman's goals.

SECTION 2: The Minutes for the meeting of March 18, 1993; copies of which had been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving monthly reports as published by the Department of activities for the month of March, 1993.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving purchase orders issued for amounts in excess of \$10,000.00, during the month of March, 1993, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into Supplemental Agreement # 9 with Kimley Horn, Inc., for further development of the additional environmental studies, roadway plans and bridge plans required to complete Hilton Head Island Expressway project at an estimated cost of \$475,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 2 with Kimley-Horn and Associates for additional engineering services related to the completion of the preliminary design of the Mark Clark Expressway project at an estimated cost of \$59,600.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 7: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to purchase a 1,709 acre tract of Black River Swamp land in Clarendon County for use as a wetland bank to secure wetland permits at an estimated cost of \$800,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 8: On motion of Commissioner Harrell, duly seconded, the Commission unanimously passed a motion to delete from the written Recommendations pending further review, Supplemental Agreement No. 3 with Post, Buckley, Schuh, and Jernigan, a financial study for the replacement of the bridges on US 17 at the Cooper River.

SECTION 9: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to advertise for and select consulting firms for the purpose of providing on call engineering services for the preparation of signing plans from June 93 to July 94 at an estimated cost of \$600,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 10: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with the United States Geological Survey (USGS) to perform site scour inspections and evaluations of bridges which cross water at an estimated cost of \$300,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 11: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 5 with Ralph Whitehead & Associates for additional services of redevelopment of preliminary plans for 1.89 miles of relocated mainline on SC Route 72 around the Town of Mountville at an estimated cost \$180,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 12: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with the City of Charleston for construction of two culverts to be placed under US Route 17 in Charleston County at estimated cost of \$490,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 13: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the allocations of transfers and closures of accounts of State Highway funds for capital improvements/land and buildings, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 14: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting a report by the Department of right of way payments on roads in the State Secondary "C" Construction Program for Aiken, Beaufort, Berkeley, Chester, Greenville, Lexington and Williamsburg Counties, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 15: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in extending an existing construction contract to include additional resurfacing work, as follows:

Chester County

Contract of Rea Construction Company - File No. 12.638 - extended to include an additional section of Project C-952 (File No. 46.953 - York County) consisting of the erection of steel beam guardrail, type A end anchors and thrie beam guardrail bridge connectors on US Route 21 at the Catawba River Bridge.

Cost of Extension \$ 30 540 00

Note: This extension was authorized by the Department prior formal approval by the Commission since the adjacent work had reached such a stage of completion that the contractor involved could not accept the additional work unless it were authorized without delay.

SECTION 16: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing award of contract for a traffic signal loop detector work in the April 6, 1993 letting for Beaufort-Berkeley-Charleston Counties, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 17: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing award of contracts covering resurfacing projects in the April 6, 1993 letting, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 18: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing award of contracts for highway construction projects in the April 6, 1993 letting subject to the approval of the Federal Highway Administration of federal-aid projects, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 19: The Commission unanimously passed a motion rejecting the bids received for highway construction projects in the April 6, 1993 letting for Cherokee, Lancaster, and Richland counties, as shown in the Appendix.

vertical clearance and remaining life) are calculated for all
bridges. Bridges in Group 1 are assigned priority for
replacement based on the cost factor. Bridges in Groups 2 and 3
with Deficiency points greater than or equal to 67 and 75,
respectively, are assigned priority based on the cost factor.
The remaining bridges in Groups 2 and 3 will be considered after
the above bridges are replaced.

The above policy shall be effective until the Department
fully implements the Federal Highway Administration mandated
Bridge Management System.

SECTION 38: On motion of Commissioner Harvey, seconded by Commissioner Atkinson, the Commission unanimously passed a motion to name the bridge at State Highway 290 and Interstate 85 in Duncan for J. Peter Grace, as follows:
