Kenneth Johnson, York, SC, DISTRICT IV: O. T. Price, Ridge Spring, SC, DISTRICT V: James H. Shirer, Elloree, SC members of the South Carolina Beef Board, expire on June 30, 2002, and, therefore, the four vacancies shall occur at that time.

The Commission shall call for nominations for said vacancies at nominating meetings at the times, places, and dates hereafter set forth:

**District 1** - 10:30 - 11:30 a.m., Monday, May 13, 2002, Spartanburg Clemson Extension Office, 142 S. Dean St., Rm. 216, Spartanburg, SC

**District 2** - 1:30 - 2:30 p.m., Tuesday, May 14, 2002, Chester Clemson Extension Office, Court House Annex, McAliley St., Chester, SC

**District 4** - 2:00 - 3:00 p.m., Monday, May 13, 2002, Greenwood County Court House, 528 Monument St., Room 200, Greenwood, SC

To qualify, a candidate must be a resident of South Carolina over the age of 25 years, having been engaged in producing beef within the State of South Carolina for a period of five years, and during that period, having derived a substantial portion of his income therefrom.

**District 1** includes the Counties of Anderson, Cherokee, Greenville, Laurens, Oconee, Pickens, Spartanburg, and Union.

**District 2** includes the Counties of Chester, Fairfield, Kershaw, Lancaster and York.

**District 3** includes the Counties of Chesterfield, Darlington, Dillon, Florence, Georgetown, Horry, Marion, Marlboro, and Williamsburg.

**District 4** includes the Counties of Abbeville, Aiken, Edgefield, Greenwood, Newberry, McCormick and Saluda.

**District 5** includes the Counties of Calhoun, Clarendon, Lee, Lexington, Orangeburg, Richland and Sumter.

**District 6** includes the Counties of Allendale, Bamberg, Barnwell, Beaufort, Berkeley, Charleston, Colleton, Dorchester, Hampton and Jasper.

Oral nominations for qualified candidates may be made at the nominating meeting and accepted by the Commission. All oral nominations for Board vacancies must be accompanied by a second to be considered for election. Nominations may also be made within five (5) days after said meeting by written petition filed with the Commission and signed by not less than five (5) affected producers entitled to participate in such meeting. The terms of office of the members elected and/or appointed to fill said vacancies shall be three (3) years.

## Commissioner's Column

### Marking Food Products for Safety

From time to time, people ask me how they can tell the origin of the food they buy. They want to know how to tell if a product is grown or processed in South Africa---or in South Carolina.

Products bearing our South Carolina Quality logo are grown and/or processed in the state. If the product does not bear the South Carolina Quality logo, ask the retailer.

It's a little more difficult to tell the country-of-origin. Federal law requires that every item from a foreign country entering the U.S. be legibly marked with the English name of the country-of-origin on the "immediate container"---the container in which the item was shipped to its destination in the U.S. The label must state where the product was manufactured, produced, or grown. The purpose of labeling country-of-origin is to inform the "ultimate purchaser" in the U.S. of the country in which the imported article was made. The ultimate purchaser is generally the last person in the U.S. who will receive the article in the form in which it was imported, but that person is not necessarily the home consumer.

All products entering the U.S. from knives and forks to cut flowers and candles must be labeled with the country-of-origin unless an exception is provided in the law. What is the exception? Believe it or not, many exceptions to the law are foodstuffs. Food items exempt from country-of-origin labeling include: eggs; livestock; maple sugar; and natural products, such as vegetables, fruit, nuts, and berries. Other exceptions include cigars or cigarettes; feathers; flowers; raw hides; unfinished leather; fur skins; and live or dead animals, fish, and birds.

The U.S. Customs Service administers and enforces the country-of-origin labeling requirement. So, if items arrive at the U.S. border in retail-ready package---such as a can of Danish ham, a slab of Dutch cheese, or a box of English candy---each must be labeled with the country-of-origin. However, if the article is destined for an U.S. processor or manufacturer where it will undergo a transformation, then that processor or manufacturer is considered the ultimate purchaser, and country-of-origin labeling on those further processed products is not required.

For example, if Mexican tomatoes or Chilean grapes are sold loosely from a bin at the supermarket, country-of-origin labeling is not required. However, if those tomatoes or grapes are wrapped in cellophane or otherwise packaged, the label is required.

The USDA's Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) is responsible for ensuring the proper labeling of all meat and poultry products for human consumption, including imports. Like other imported items, the country-of-origin must appear in English on the immediate containers of all meat and poultry products entering the U.S. Only plants in countries certified by USDA to have inspection systems equivalent to those of the U.S. are eligible to export products to the U.S. But, if the imported meats and poultry are further processed in a domestic, USDA-inspected establishment, country-of-origin labeling is not required on either the new product or its container.

For example, if a U.S. establishment slices Danish ham and repackages those slices, neither that establishment nor the retailer is required to label the package to indicate that it is imported meat.

A number of bills aimed at expanding country-of-origin labeling requirements for meats and other agricultural products have been introduced in Congress. Expanding the country-of-origin labeling requirements on meats and other agricultural products could help reduce the risks associated with food from certain countries---countries which use chemical products that are prohibited on food crops in the U.S., countries which use certain antibiotics in animals that are not allowed in the U.S. Consumers provided with the origin of their food at the retail level are more likely to choose home grown and processed over food from other countries.

## Emergency Conservation Program Funds Available for Peach Producers in the Ridge

J. Kenneth Rentiers, Jr., Farm Service Agency State Executive Director, and Alfred H. Vang, South Carolina Department of Natural Resources Deputy Director, are pleased to announce that federal funding through Farm Service Agency has been approved for peach producers in the Ridge area of South Carolina. Due to continued drought, irrigation ponds in the Ridge area of South Carolina have not adequately recharged. The Ridge area includes portions of Aiken, Edgefield, Lexington, and Saluda Counties.

Farm Service Agency will receive an initial funding of approximately \$500,000, to provide 50% cost-share assistance to eligible peach producers in the Ridge area to install wells and pipelines needed to recharge irrigation ponds. Technical expertise in locating appropriate well sites will be provided by the Hydrology Section of the South Carolina Department of Natural Resources.

Interested peach producers in Aiken, Edgefield, Lexington, and Saluda Counties should contact their local USDA-Farm Service Agency for more information.
