**Palmetto Fellows Scholarship Awards for FY 1999-2000**

In order to be eligible to apply for the Palmetto Fellows Scholarship, all applicants must meet the following three criteria: 1) score 1200 on the SAT or equivalent ACT score by the application deadline; 2) earn a 3.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale through the end of the junior year; and 3) rank in the top five percent of either the sophomore or junior class.

For 1999-2000 704 scholarships were awarded (600 public and 104 private). Of the 1,036 who applied 999 students were offered scholarships in the multiple rounds of scholarship offers. The attached tables reflect the new Palmetto Fellows Scholarships awarded as well as the continuing Palmetto Fellows Scholarships. Also attached is a map of the counties in South Carolina depicting the number of applicants from each county.


