**WHEREAS,** the 2015 observance of Sexual Assault Awareness Month calls attention to sexual violence and educates the public and individuals on how to prevent, treat, and heal from this personal violation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim April 2015 as**
