

The amount of this grant award is authorized under the provisions of section 1903(a)(3) of the Act, as amended by section 4201 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA, Public Law 111-5, enacted on February 17, 2009), providing for Health Information Technology (HIT) Administration Recovery Act. The amount of this grant award is provided to encourage the adoption and use of certified EHR technology.

Computation of this grant award is shown on the enclosed statement.

With the acceptance of this award you agree to be responsible for limiting the drawing of Federal funds so as to minimize Federal cash on hand in accordance with policies established in Treasury Circular 1075 (revised) and procedures established by the Department of Health and Human Services. 

A. **\$562,000** represents the total Health Information Technology (HIT) funding provided due to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). This is provided in accordance with Section 1903(a)(3) of the Social Security Act as amended by Section 4201. See Attachment 1.

B. In accordance with section 4201 of ARRA, this grant represents the Federal funding provided for certain State expenditures to Medicaid providers to encourage the adoption and use of certified electronic health technology record (EHR) technology and associated Administrative costs. This grant award represents the Federal share portion of funds to be used for this purpose.
