Subject: Emergency Work Extension Requests

Good Afternoon All,

One more reminder that the deadline to complete emergency work is April 4, 2016. This does not mean that your project worksheets have to be complete, it just means the work itself must be complete by that date. If your emergency work is complete, no further action is required from your end; however, if you are still continuing emergency work, please be mindful of the deadline and the process outlined below for requesting an extension.

If you are still conducting emergency work and will continue to do so past April 4th, you will need to request an extension in order for the work and associated costs to be considered eligible by FEMA. You can do this one of two ways, you can submit a request in writing to Kim Stenson, the Director of the South Carolina Emergency Management Division or use SC Recovery Grants to request the extension electronically following the instructions on this link:

If you need to request a time extensions please include the identification of the project by project worksheet number, the dates and provisions of any previous extensions granted for the particular project, a detailed justification of the need for the extension, and a projected completion date. The justification should be based on extenuating circumstances or unusual project requirements beyond the control of the applicant.

We have received several extension requests, and a written response will be provided to those applicants by the end of this week. If you have any questions about requesting an extension or the status of your submitted request, please contact me or your assigned State Project Specialist.
