The National Council on Aging (NCOA) is currently seeking proposals from nonprofit or public agencies for the Senior SNAP Enrollment Initiative, a national program to fight senior hunger by increasing the enrollment of older adults (age 60+) in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP).

Through this initiative, NCOA will award up to \$1,150,000 total in grants to community-based organizations and agencies to assist older adults in the SNAP application and enrollment process.
