Commissioners Love, Lynn and Batson,

The Senate is prepared to proceed with your re-appointments to CHE as forwarded by Governor Haley. Our next Education Committee meeting is scheduled for March 23 at 10:00 a.m., and we would like to invite you to come for your screening at that time.

I know you have all been through the process before, but as a reminder, the screening process works as follows:

- Appointees are screened at the beginning of our meeting, prior to considering any legislation.
- Appointees are placed under oath and asked to make a brief (1-2 minutes, please) opening statement as to why they wish to serve.
- Appointees are asked a series of "yes or no" questions by staff. These questions have already been answered on your application, and I have attached them for your convenience.
- Committee members may ask questions of appointees or make comments on the nomination.
- The Committee will vote on whether to forward the appointment/re-appointment to the full Senate for confirmation.
- Appointments are confirmed following Executive Sessions of the Senate and appointees are notified of confirmation by the Committee and the Clerk of the Senate.

Generally each appointee's screening takes approximately 10 minutes. Once your screening has concluded you may feel free to leave the meeting, but are welcome to stay.

I hope you are able to join us on March 23. If the date is not suitable to you, we will reschedule as quickly as possible. Please feel free to respond to this message, but I will follow up with a phone call as well.
