

MINUTES OF BUDGET AND CONTROL BOARD MEETING

OCTOBER 10, 1962

The State Budget and Control Board met in the office of the State Auditor at 3:00 P. M., on October 10, 1962. Mr. Aycock and General Rhodes were present at this meeting.

The meeting was attended by the Honorable Walter Bristow, State Senator from Richland County, Mr. Heyward Belser and Mr. Eli Walker, members of the Richland County House Delegation, and the Secretary of the Richland County Delegation. These gentlemen desired to have assurance from the State Budget and Control Board that Richland County could borrow the sum of \$250,000.00 after the General Election, if the then determined delegation submitted a letter of intention to issue bonds during the year 1963 from which the loan would be repaid. The Board gave the members of the delegation this assurance.

The Board agreed to begin hearings on the 1963-1964 appropriation requests on October 30, and to hold hearings four days each week until they had been completed. It was estimated that two weeks would be required for this function.

The State Auditor was directed to prepare a schedule for these hearings and to notify each of the departments of the time set therefor.

The Board agreed, subject to approval of the absent members, to supply the sum of \$3,200.00 to the Probation, Parole and Pardon Board for the employment of an additional Probation Officer in the northeastern section of the State, together with \$800.00 for travel during the remainder of the current ~~year~~ fiscal year.

The meeting then adjourned.
