

- South Carolina is the No. 1 tire producer in the U.S.
- Bridgestone, Continental, and Michelin combine to employ roughly 11,000 people.
- Tire companies have invested \$3.5 billion into South Carolina since 2011

- South Carolina has 10 active tire plants - more than any other U.S. state.
- Nearly 30 percent of tires exported from the U.S. come from South Carolina, the top-ranked tire-exporting state.
- South Carolina tire exports totaled \$1.6 billion in 2014.
