

Goat Producers to Hold Clinic

The SC Goat Producers will hold a goat artificial insemination clinic for meat, dairy, fiber, or any other type of goats at Split Creek Farm, 3806 Centerville Rd. in Anderson, SC, on Friday, November 10th, 2000, from 9 AM to 4 PM.

Karen Lewis, Instructor from Frozen Assets in California will be on hand to provide information about goat artificial insemination. The clinic is being offered to help goat producers learn more about artificial insemination, since there are only a few companies in the nation that provide this service.

The clinic is an excellent opportunity for goat producers to learn how to establish a market for bucks and/or kids from a buck for the future. Six producers will be allowed to bring goats to be artificially inseminated. Producers must schedule an appointment for buck collection which will be held on Sunday, November 12th, 2000.

To qualify, a candidate for Board membership must be a resident of South Carolina and of the district wherein nominated, over the age of twenty-five years, having been engaged in producing soybeans within the State of South Carolina for a period of five years and during that period, having derived a substantial portion of his or her income therefrom.

Any producer within the district wherein nominated who produced soybeans during the past year is entitled to participate in the meeting.

District 1 includes the Counties of Abbeville, Anderson, Cherokee, Chester, Chesterfield, Fairfield, Greenville, Greenwood, Kershaw, Lancaster, Laurens, McCormick, Newberry, Oconee, Pickens, Saluda, Spartanburg, Union, and York

District 3 includes the Counties of Clarendon, Darlington, Florence, Lee, Marlboro, and Sumter

Commissioner's Column

Plant A Row This Fall

Didn't find the time to plant your garden last spring? It's not too late! In fact, fall is one of the best times of the year for planting. And, one of the best places to find your fall plants and flowers is at the Fall Plant and Flower Festivals.

Fall is a great time to work in the garden and beautify the yard for the coming winter, but did you know that fall is a good time for planting, too? It's a scientific fact that plants grow the majority of their root system in the fall and winter. Abundant root systems create much stronger plants.

When you get ready to plant your fall vegetable garden, don't forget to PLANT-A-ROW FOR THE HUNGRY. Plant an extra row of leafy greens or other fall vegetable. An estimated 30 million Americans, including elderly people and children, go to bed hungry each night or not knowing when their next meal will be. But, a group of Upstate gardeners is doing something about it!

The Master Gardeners of Spartanburg County's PLANT-A-ROW FOR THE HUNGRY effort has been successful this past summer despite the lack of rain. The group has planted and harvested two vegetable gardens, and all of the produce has gone to the Soup Kitchen, Children's Shelter, and the Downtown Rescue Mission. The Master Gardeners delivered about 1,700 pounds of vegetables to help feed the less fortunate. In addition, they have delivered thousands of pounds of peaches, nectarines, apples, and pears donated by three Upstate Farms---Cash Farms on Rt. 110 north of Cowpens, Cooley Farms on Hwy. 11 west of Chesnee, and Perdue's Mountain Fruit Farm also on Highway 11 at Tigerville Road.

"Because of the generosity of Charlie Gray at Cash Farms, James Cooley and his daughter Brandi at Cooley Farms, and Dick Perdue at Perdue's Mountain Fruit Farm, we have been able to deliver 7,000 pounds of produce to feed the hungry from our garden at Spartanburg Tech and from local farmers," said Bob Ludwick of the Master Gardeners of Spartanburg.

The Garden Writers Association of America started the PLANT A ROW FOR THE HUNGRY program in 1995, and HGTV joined the effort in 1999. The effort has been so successful that more than a million pounds of fresh fruits and vegetables have been donated to the hungry by gardeners in the US and Canada since the program's inception six years ago.

Gardeners already share knowledge, seeds, plants, and harvests with their gardening neighbors. Now they are working together to share their harvests with others in need. Most gardeners harvest more than they consume, so they are working to help local food banks. The best thing you can do is join local gardeners you know for one big contribution. If you are not sure where to donate your excess fruits and vegetables, you can call "Second Harvest" at (206) 545-666, and they will refer you to a qualified relief organization. If you think that you can't make a difference, think again! Look what the Master Gardeners of Spartanburg did!

If you want to join the effort, the plan is simple. Call your local food bank to see if they would like to have your fresh produce. Plant an additional row in your fall garden and deliver the harvest. You can participate as an individual or join friends or social groups. Record your donations. Charitable contributions for the cost of producing the fruits and vegetables are tax deductible. To support your claim to a deduction, ask for a receipt from the organization to which you donate.

So, whether you're planning to join the effort and plant a row for the hungry in your fall vegetable garden or you're just adding a little color to your garden, visit the Pee Dee Fall Plant and Flower Festival, Friday-Sunday, October 6-8, 2000, at the Pee Dee State Farmers Market, 2513 West Lucas Street in Florence and the Midlands Fall Plant and Flower Festival, Friday-Sunday, October 20-22, 2000, at the Columbia State Farmers Market, 1001 Bluff Road in Columbia. Hours for both festivals will be 8am to 6pm, Friday-Saturday, and 1pm to 6pm on Sunday.

Agri-marketers, temporarily set up at the markets, will be on-hand during the fall festivals with lots of plants and flowers---chrysanthemums, pansies, snapdragons, ornamental cabbage, kale, among many others. In addition to those plants and flowers that will be sure to put instant color in the garden, don't forget that there will be lawn and garden-related items and plenty of vegetable plants for those who plant fall vegetable gardens.

I commend the **Master Gardeners of Spartanburg County** and all who plant an extra row for the hungry in the state. When you plant a garden, you're creating an environment that nurtures family togetherness while providing nutritious fruits and vegetables for your table. So, visit the upcoming Fall Plant and Flower Festivals, buy some garden plants, and plant-a-row or two this fall for your family.
