

Mrs. C. B. Dreher *She State 12/15/44* Dies; Rites Today

Last rites for Mrs. Mamie D. Dreher, 79, of Gonzales Gardens, who died at the Columbia hospital early Thursday morning, will be conducted at 3 o'clock this afternoon at the Dunbar Funeral home by the Rev. C. E. Fritz, pastor of Ebenezer Lutheran church. Interment will follow in Kelly cemetery.
