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Subject: D-SNAP

Residency: in most cases, the household must have lived in the disaster area at the time of the disaster AND have experienced at least one of three adverse effects: 1) loss of income; 2) inaccessible liquid resources; or 3) out of pocket disaster related expenses.

Income: eligibility based on Disaster Gross Income Limit (DGIL) which is currently at \$1640 per month for an individual, and \$2693 per month for a family of four. DGIL is calculated by adding take-home income and accessible resources, then subtracting disaster related expenses paid out of pocket during benefit period.
