Greetings,

I am without more than \$400,000 in salary and benefits, so I respectfully asked Federal law enforcement officials and others to investigate and cease, desist Richland County (South Carolina) Probate Court orders for case 2017MI401026 (rendered on September 5,

2017), case 2017MI401404 (rendered on October 16, 2017), and/or other case(s) deriving from the initial petition.

I am concerned Richland County Probate Court:

1. Violated my constitutional rights and the color of law. For example, during the hearing on September 5, 2017, a law enforcement officer testified under oath that police case 2016104-0105 in Alexandria, Virginia (Franconia District/Fairfax County) is a mental health case. However, "mental health case" is not listed as what Franconia District citizens should report (see the attachment: <https://www.fairfaxcounty.gov/police/reportcrime/>). Also, Dr. Tanya Dillihay and Kathleen Ryan, PSY-1, the court-appointed examiners, presented separate testimonies under oath that seemed inconsistent with the U.S. Constitution, American Psychological Association, "Ethical Principles of Psychologists and Code of Conduct," and other standards for evaluating those who are allegedly mentally ill. The court-appointed examiners only evaluated my use of silence/constitutional rights on August 29, 2017 for less than 30 minutes. The above witnesses seemed to use fraud, false evidence, abuse of authority, and/or illegal methods to deprive me of a right protected by the U.S. Constitution or law.

2. Committed or is committing involuntary manslaughter/criminal negligence (see Section 16-3-60 of a South Carolina law) through the orders. For example, Judge Ralph J. Smiley used "must" and "all" in the court orders. I believe the restrictive, inflexible terms render the court-ordered treatment as detrimental to my health and unreasonable. My well-being, medical history (e.g. multiple sclerosis or temporary cardiac issues), and desires were disregarded in the court orders. Additionally, when I tried to respectfully give an account of the October 16th hearing or state my beliefs to Dr. Butterfield on October 30, the doctor replied more than once, "I don't care." "I don't care" is an emphatic disregard for my well-being. How can the court-ordered treatment empower me or add value when the process includes people like Dr. Butterfield who stated, "I don't care"? Is the South Carolina judicial petition process infested with color of law violations, fraud, involuntary manslaughter/criminal negligence, or, worse yet, murder for money (see Section 44-17-660 of a South Carolina law)?

As a result of these or other offenses, I am without more than \$400,000 in salary and benefits and I am unable to seek care from compassionate medical professionals, such as my neurologist, in Virginia. Unfortunately, I cannot address matters related to police case 2016104-0105 without obstruction from South Carolina through Richland County Probate Court. Will you please investigate, cease and desist the South Carolina court orders, and cancel permanently all court-ordered sessions, including the follow-on appointments for November 30, 2017 at 9:30 a.m. EST and December 15, 2017 at 1:15 p.m. EST at Richland County Health Department? Thank you for your consideration and happy holidays.
