I am aware of an informal AG Opinion dated February 23, 2001, regarding Judge Duffy's order on weighted voting following the *Vander Linden v. Hodges* case from the Fourth Circuit, which indicates that single branch delegation voting must be determined by weighted vote pursuant to a specific formula.

However, I would advise Senator Hayes to seek legal advice from the Senate Clerk's Office regarding the process for a delegation nomination for a magistrate.
