BEAUFORT IMMIGRATION RALLY PLANNED

The Lowcountry Immigration Coalition and its allies will hold a rally for comprehensive immigration reform on **Saturday, October 5, 2013**, from Noon to 1:30 outside the office of Congressman Mark Sanford, 903 Port Republic Street, Beaufort, South Carolina.

This effort, called GIVE US A VOTE, is in support of the National Immigration Day of Dignity and Respect which encourages the passage of immigration reform with a path to citizenship for the estimated 11 million undocumented immigrants in our Nation.

Major business groups, virtually all National and State faith communities, law enforcement, and over 67% of South Carolinians support comprehensive reform. The U.S. House of Representatives needs to allow a vote on this important moral issue.

This peaceful rally will be confined to the sidewalks outside and near his office. Participants are urged to **wear white tee-shirts** in solidarity with the individuals in over 100 cities marching on that date. Please bring signs of your own and use such phrases as "Dignity/Dignidad, Respect/Respeto, the Time is Now/Es Tiempo, Freedom, Justice, or any other slogans.

And, bring along an American flag if you can to show that we are all Americans and aspiring Americans.

NOTE: Be very careful where you park at the waterfront or on side streets to avoid parking tickets.

Let us show the Lowcountry and the Congressman that the Hispanic and Anglo communities are united and we want action on comprehensive reform. GIVE US A VOTE--Now is the TIME!!!!
