Swati – Do you approve of sending e-mail to Aiken delegation?

Today, the S.C. Attorney General will file suit against the U.S. Department of Energy and other Defendants in the U.S. District Court, Aiken Division, related to MOX and requests the following relief –

- 1- Removal of 1 metric ton of defense plutonium or defense plutonium materials
- 2- Prevent Ds from moving, transferring, or agreeing to, allowing, facilitating, authorizing, or taking any similar conduct or action resulting in the movement or transfer of any defense plutonium or defense plutonium material to the SRS, regardless of origin, until Court enters an order finding Ds are in full compliance with Section 2566 and is achieving the MOX production objective
- 3- Payment of impact assistance payments in the amount of \$1 million per day, beginning on Jan. 1, until the earlier of the first 100 days of 2016 or the date Ds remove an additional 1 metric ton of defense plutonium or defense plutonium materials
- 4- Court to retain jurisdiction
- 5- Require Ds to provide a status update to Court on 101st date of each year in 2017 – 2021 to include, 1 – whether the MOX production objective has been met, 2 – whether one metric ton of defense plutonium or defense plutonium material has been removed during that calendar year, and 3 – whether a legal constraint exists prohibiting the provision of economic and impact assistance due to SC
- 6- Attorney's fees and costs
