SUMMARY REPORT

Meeting of Commission on Higher Education, October 3, 1985

TEACHER LOAN
PROGRAM for
1986-87

The provision of the Education Improvement Act (EIA) of 1984 authorizing the Teacher Loan Program states that appropriations for loans and administrative costs shall be provided in annual amounts recommended by the Commission on Higher Education. The Commission agreed to recommend to the State Board of Education that \$2.5 million be requested for loans and administrative costs for the program for 1986-87.

TEACHER
RECRUITMENT
PROGRAM, 1985-86

The 1985-86 Appropriation Act directs the State Department of Education to transfer \$236,000 of unexpended EIA funds to the Commission on Higher Education for the purpose of funding requests for proposals for the creation or implementation of teacher recruitment programs through agencies of State government or private industry. The Commission approved guidelines to implement the program in 1985-86.

CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENTS

The Commission approved a request by Piedmont Technical College for authorization to purchase three acres of land opposite its newly acquired Vocational Center.

ANNUAL REPORT

The Commission approved the 1984-85 Annual Report on Implementation of the State Desegregation Plan.

STATUS REPORT

Also approved was the Commission's response to the Office for Civil Rights concerning that office's response to the Annual Report on Implementation of the South Carolina Desegregation Plan for 1983-84 and Fall 1984.
