The State Budget and Control Board met in the office of the State Auditor at 10:30 A. M. on December 6. All members of the Board were present.

The Board approved an allocation from the Civil Contingent Fund of \$3,000.00 to the Contractors' Licensing Board to cover the cost of examinations held by the Board during the current year.

The Board approved a plan presented by the Employment Security Commission to supplement its Merit System with further consideration for employees who had been with the Commission over a long period, the plan being known as a Longevity Plan. The details of the plan are filed with the Board.

After further discussion, the Board approved definite policies to be followed in preparing the Budget for the Year 1957-58, and directed the Secretary to proceed with the printing of the Budget.

The Board then adjourned.
