

**Baroness Tessa Jowell** served as a Member of British Parliament from 1992-2015. Throughout these years, she held several positions in government, such as Minister of State for Public Health (1997-1999), Minister of State for Employment, Welfare to Work and Equal Opportunities (1999-2001), and Secretary of State for Culture, Media and Sport and member of the Cabinet (2001-2007).

Baroness Jowell also initiated and managed the winning bid for the London 2012 Olympics and Paralympics and led the development of the project for eight years.

Prior to becoming a Member of Parliament, Baroness Jowell's career included experience in public service as a mental health practitioner, senior manager, public service reform expert, and social policy analyst.

Baroness Jowell serves on the Advisory Board of the [Ministerial Leadership in Health Program](#), a joint initiative of the Harvard Chan School of Public Health and the Harvard Kennedy School of Government.


