SECTION 1: The Minutes for the meeting of July 26, 1996, copies of which had been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: On motion of Commissioner Self, seconded by Commissioner Goodstein, the Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) as presented by the Department with the following exception: in Greenwood County, the eastern bypass funding be transferred to the western bypass due to changes in traffic patterns and use.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion amending the Anderson County Transportation Plan, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

AMENDMENT TO ANDERSON COUNTY TRANSPORTATION PLAN

The third and fourth sentences of the third paragraph of Section 1 are deleted. These sentences currently read "The officers may not serve in the office of Chairman, Vice-Chairman or Secretary for more than one (1) consecutive year. They may not succeed themselves in these offices but may be elected by the membership to serve again in these offices after they have been out of them for one year."

The above sentences will be replaced by the following: "The Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Secretary may serve two (2) consecutive one year terms, but may not serve a third consecutive term. Elections will be held in December of each odd numbered year and in January of each even numbered year after the Anderson County Legislative Delegation makes appointments to the committee."

EXTENSION OF CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS

It is recommended that the Commission approve the action of the Department in extending existing construction contracts to include additional work, as follows:

GEORGETOWN COUNTY:

Contract of APAC-Carolina, Inc. - File No. 22.629 - extended to include Local Paving Project (File No. 22.638L) consisting of the surfacing with asphalt concrete surfacing on Newt Place from S-195 (Hickory Drive) to Player Road and on Player Road from Newt Place to U.
