All Delegates are nominated by their teachers or the Academy based on proven academic excellence and demonstrated desire to enter the medical profession. The Congress of Future Medical Leaders has strict academic requirements, and students must have a minimum 3.5 GPA (or equivalent) to be nominated. Students at the Congress represent all fifty states and Puerto Rico.

Some five hundred places at the Congress are reserved for students on full academic scholarship who are selected by their teacher or guidance counselor based on their leadership ability, academic achievement and dedication. In addition, the Academy is proud to offer partial scholarships for students with financial need.

The National Academy of Future Physicians and Medical Scientists was founded on the belief that we must identify prospective medical talent at the earliest possible age and help these students acquire the necessary experience and skills to take them to the doorstep of this vital career.


