MINUTES

Mr. Poore called the meeting to order and Mr. Bratcher gave the invocation.

On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Gerrard, Council voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the February 15, 1977 meeting as mailed.

Reverend Woodrow Thomason requested Council pay the balance due on the church organ at the County Stockade. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Wright, Council voted unanimously to receive Reverend Thomason information to be voted upon at Council's next formal meeting.

Mr. C. R. Johnson presented a Resolution requesting Council designate the Planning and Development Board as the Agency authorized to prepare an Overall Economic Development Plan for Anderson County. Mr. Charles Diamond of the South Carolina Appalachian Council of Governments gave Council an overview of the EDA Program. He stated that an OEDP is an inventory of statistics concerning the County's economy and a listing of projects that will help the unemployment rate fall and help long-term economic growth in the County. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to sign the Resolution. Council suggested that the Council of Governments work with the Planning and Development Board.

Mr. Hooper stated that he felt the County should provide parking for its employees. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Gerrard, Council voted unanimously to receive Mr. Hooper's remarks as information.

Mr. Poore stated that he feels Council should do something immediately about the burial of dead animals in the County. On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Gerrard, Council voted unanimously to ask Mr. Karl Kenyon, County Attorney, to check into this matter.

Council approved payment of bills for the month of January, 1977.

On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Wright, Council voted unanimously to adjourn at 9:53 a.m.
