This Agreement is intended to memorialize understandings related to the voluntary retirement of HERMAN P. SNYDER (SNYDER), an employee of the COMMISSION OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS AND PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION (COMMISSION). Both SNYDER and COMMISSION, as the parties to this Agreement, recognize that the agreement contemplates sacrifices and concessions on both sides, with the ultimate objective being to enable SNYDER and his family to pursue their private lives freed of the pressures of public employment, while enabling the COMMISSION to fulfill its duties in providing the South Carolina Department of Highways and Public Transportation (Department) with the earliest possible replacement for the position of State Highway Engineer, consistent with the dictates of Section 57-3-470 of the 1976 South Carolina Code of Laws, as amended.

The parties therefore enter into this Agreement as follows:

1. SNYDER agrees to voluntarily retire as State Highway Engineer, effective August 18, 1990.
2. SNYDER agrees to make himself available at no compensation to the Department as consultant and/or witness for a period of six (6) months from date of retirement, in order to permit smooth transition of responsibility for matters peculiarly within the knowledge of SNYDER, and to enable Department access to SNYDER as an engineering or other witness for the Department

in matters in litigation where SNYDER is required by Court Order, subpoena, or other legal means to appear as witness for deposition or trial.

②
3. SNYDER further agrees to release the COMMISSION, including its past and present members, and the Department, including its past and present officers and employees, from any and all liability, if any, resulting from SNYDER'S employment with the Department and SNYDER'S voluntary retirement from employment with the Department.

4. SNYDER agrees not to seek future salaried employment with the Department, it being understood by all parties that it is not the intention of this provision to prevent SNYDER and any future employer of SNYDER from being utilized in the future as an independent engineering consultant or contractor for the Department or any other agency of State government.

5. Department agrees to pay the South Carolina State Retirement System the sum of Seventy Thousand (\$70,000.) Dollars to be considered by the parties as mandatory tax deferred contribution to the retirement account of HERMAN P. SNYDER.


6. This Agreement is contractual and not merely recital.

The aforesaid Agreement is entered into freely and voluntarily by both parties, in hopes of amicably resolving a strained employment situation generated by events of the past year, with this Agreement intending to enable the parties to

proceed with private lives on the one hand, and statutory responsibilities on the other hand.

STATEMENT
SOUTH CAROLINA HIGHWAY COMMISSION
AUGUST 7, 1990

The South Carolina Department of Highways and Public Transportation Commission expressed appreciation for the 34 years of faithful and dedicated service of Colonel J. H. "Red" Lanier to the Highway Patrol. In accepting Colonel Lanier's resignation to its Executive Director, the Commission acknowledged that as stated by Colonel Lanier it was because of his respect for the Patrol as a strong and important institution of South Carolina Government and his desire to avoid controversy and any loss of public confidence in the Patrol.

The Commission supported the appointment of 24 year veteran Major Ron Alford as Acting Commander of the Patrol. It stands behind Major Alford as interim commander.

The Commission expressed disappointment that it was not informed until July 24 of the incident involving the FBI special agent which occurred in March, despite the fact that other authorities were aware of it. The Commission confirmed that the proper agency for the enforcement of the statutes dealing with the operation of motor vehicles and the investigation of accidents upon the highways is the Department of Highways and Public Transportation through the Patrol.

The Commission expressed confidence in and appreciation for the officers and troopers of the Patrol and the selfless service they render.

The Executive Director reported that no report has been received from the U. S. Attorneys office or the Federal Grand Jury with regard to their investigation of the action of certain

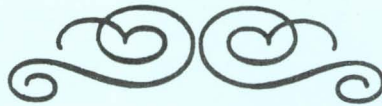
road construction firms with which investigation the Department is fully cooperating.

The Commission will meet immediately upon any new developments affecting the Department and its responsibilities for the highway system of South Carolina.

The Commission will take positive steps to restore unity and morale and stand behind the employees of the Department of Highways and Public Transportation. The Commission will evaluate Division Heads throughout the Department to restore confidence in the Highway Department with the public.

SECTION 1: The Minutes of the meetings of July 19, 1990 and August 7, 1990; copies of which have been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving purchase orders issued for amounts in excess of \$1,000.00 during the month of July, 1990, as shown in the Appendix.

AMENDMENT TO THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FY '90-'91 PROGRAM OF PROJECTS

Included in the authorization were 100% UMTA Section 8 funds for planning projects for the Fairfield County Transit System (Item No.: PT-212) and Williamsburg County Transit System (Item No.: 213).
