Description/Significant Features:

Rectangular plan; side-gabled roof, with a single, front-facing gable. Off-center door is flanked by paired six-over-six, double-hung, wooden sash windows on either side. The northern two bays, located within the front-gabled section, are beneath a hipped roof porch that is supported by decorative metal posts. A square attic vent is centered within the front gable. The porch floor is concrete and is supported by a continuous brick foundation; porch access is via a central concrete stair. The exterior of the house is covered with fiberboard siding and the roof is covered with composition shingles.
