Plans are under way for major improvements at one of the state's most historic sites: Colonial Dorchester in Summerville. A visitors center and new exhibits will help tell the story of the remarkably preserved archaeological remains of the town that flourished on the banks of the upper Ashley River for nearly a hundred years until the Revolutionary War. One big first step already has taken place: The construction of a new residence for the park manager. Thanks to the generosity of Harbor Homes and the Mungo Companies, the new home replaces an older residence that now can be removed to make way for a new visitors center in the future.
