Male painted buntings, one of the most colorful songbirds in North America, have finally arrived at Huntington Beach State Park!

The birds showed up at the Nature Center feeders on April 7. A total of 3 males have been seen thus far, constantly chasing each other. They are very territorial, and pack a lot of fight into a little package. You may be able to attract buntings to your home feeder, if you live in the right habitat. In SC, they are found mostly in the coastal plain, especially near salt marshes and maritime forests. They prefer plain white millet, hold the filler please!

Some of the buntings at the park have been banded over the last few years, sporting color combinations that make each unique. Researchers encourage everyone to get involved in this citizen scientist project. 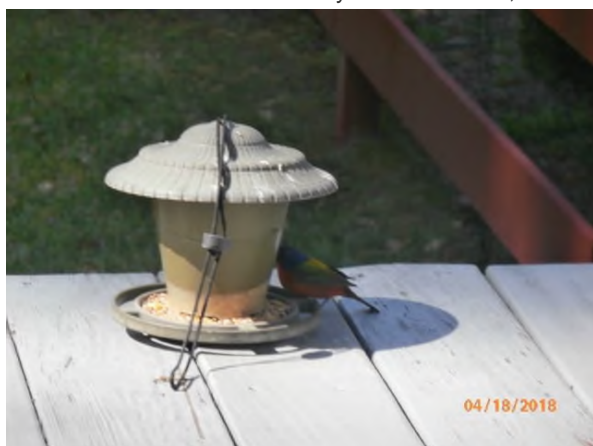
