Dear ADSSP and ADI-SSS grantees and collaborative partners,

We want to notify you that the National Research Summit on Care, Services, and Supports for Persons with Dementia and their Caregivers will be held October 16-17, 2017 at the NIH Campus in Bethesda, Maryland.

The Summit is sponsored by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and private sector organizations. The meeting will be open to the public and free of charge; more information on how to attend and registration details will be available in the coming months.

The goal of the Summit is to identify what information is needed to accelerate the development, evaluation, translation, implementation, and scaling up of comprehensive care, services, and supports for persons with dementia, families, and other caregivers. The Summit sessions will be focused on research that is needed to improve quality of care and outcomes across care settings, including quality of life and the lived experience of persons with dementia and their caregivers. Some of the anticipated outcomes from the Summit include developing recommendations for research priorities to inform federal agencies, foundations, and private sector organizations and identifying evidence-based programs, strategies, and approaches that can be used now to improve care and services for people with dementia and their caregivers.
