Shall Come, GREETINGS:*

WHEREAS, a requisition has been received from Her Excellency the Governor of the **State of Louisiana** for the rendition of **James Dickerson**, who stands charged with the crimes of **Aggravated Rape**. It has been represented to me further that such Fugitive has fled there from and taken refuge in the State of South Carolina.

NOW THEREFORE, I, MARK SANFORD, Governor of the State of South Carolina, do hereby command that the said fugitive be delivered to **Investigator Danny Ward, Louisiana Attorney General's Office and/or Detective Lt. Dawn C. Bergeron, Terrebonne Sheriff's Department and/or their lawful designees who are authorized** to carry **James Dickerson** to the **State of Louisiana** for trial, in accordance with the laws in such case made and provided.
